Measures 1-4 of the first movement. The piano part consists of a continuous eighth-note accompaniment. The violin part begins with a slur over measures 1-2, followed by a slur over measures 3-4. Fingering numbers are indicated above the notes.

Measures 5-8. The violin part continues with slurs and specific fingering numbers. The piano accompaniment remains consistent.

Measures 9-12. Measure 9 introduces a key signature change to F# major. A crescendo hairpin is present in the piano part. The violin part continues with slurs and fingering.

Measures 13-16. The violin part concludes with slurs and a fermata in the final measure.
